The aforementioned player hereby requests, with the express consent of their parents, tutor or guardian, to be registered as a player at Boca Juniors Academy at North Miami Beach.

Both parties agree to the following provisions:

FIRST.- The purpose of this contract is the participation of the player at Boca Juniors Academy at North Miami Beach, attending the training sessions, according to the schedule established at the beginning of the season by the club

NOTE:

The participation in tournaments will be conditioned to the fulfillment of the commitments assumed by the parents of the players in time and form (payment of fees, delivery of documentation, etc.). The academy will do everything possible so that each player can compete in the tournaments in which he participates, but this will be conditioned to the performance of the player and his commitment to the practices. Being registered does not oblige the Academy to play the student in all the competitions in which he participates.

SECOND.- This contract shall be valid from June 1st 2018 until May 31st 2019. Training sessions start on August 1st 2018 and ends on May 31st 2019. Both parties shall be required to sign a new contract if they wish to renew the agreement after that date.

In consideration for the services provided, the parties agree that the parents/tutors of the player shall pay Boca Juniors Academy the following sums:

RECREATIVE LEVEL:

\$ 140 This service fee will be paid in advance and will entitle you to participate in 10 consecutive practices. After the 10 practices, this fee should be paid again to access another equal period of training

COMPETITIVE

Players will be placed into teams as applicable to their level of skill and appropriate to their physical abilities. Teams will be registered to the league or tournament appropriate to their level of competitiveness. There are numerous leagues all of varying driving distances. Generally speaking, the more competitive the team the further the driving distances.

Training will consist of three days of soccer training and one day of speed and agility per week. Mon, Tues, Wed, and Thursday training.

Goalkeeper training included

The fees must be paid from 1 to 10 of each month without exception. The contracting of the services implies a commitment for the entire training cycle of the Academy. The fact that the player does not attend a certain number of practices does not release the responsible of the contract to the payment of the commitments assumed.

Pre- Academy:

\$ 1.600 for the season 2018 / 2019. Payment schedule will be: \$340 at signing this contract and nine monthly consecutive payments of \$140 in value of service.

Academy:

\$ 2.000 for the season 2018 / 2019. Payment schedule will be: \$340 at signing this contract and nine monthly consecutive payments of \$185 in value of service.



The annual fee for the Pre Academy and Academy levels includes training uniforms (2 t-Shirts, 2 shorts and 2 socks).

In case of loss or damage to these uniforms, the replacement of the uniforms will be the responsibility of the parents, guardians or responsible.

For Competitive teams it is mandatory to purchase the competition uniform at the time the academy director assigns a place in the team and the corresponding numbering.

An extra charge of \$ 35 will be added as a penalty for each payment made on the 10th of each month and a charge of \$ 35 for each rejected check.

If a student owes more than one monthly fee, service shall be temporarily suspended, until the debt is settled.

If the player does not attend a certain number of practices it does not release the responsible of the contract to the payment of the commitments assumed.

THIRD.- The school shall function according to the activity Schedule, posted through the premises or on the website. Times and places may be changed or modified according to weather conditions or any other situation that may arise. The school shall inform the changes to the parents or tutors and the players. The school will provide access to a exclusive mobile application and to the official group at Facebook. Both will be the official media channel between School and parents, guardians and players.

FOURTH.- The player may access the premises only during the scheduled times. The use of an ID card is mandatory, and it shall be requested upon entering the premises.

FIFTH.- The player, their parents, tutors and/or legal representatives, agree to follow instructions given by the group coach, the medical team and/or coordinators and/or other Boca Juniors Schools authorities, to achieve the best possible personal and physical development for the player. The player agrees to show up on time and with the right gear to all training sessions and matches.

SIXTH.- The player attends soccer classes in order to improve their sports training and education, and their enrollment in the Boca Juniors School is voluntary. As soccer is a contact sport, the player, their parents, tutor and/or guardian assume all responsibility for any injury or accident that may occur as a result of the activities scheduled during training sessions, matches, tours and/or training camps, even in cases of unforeseeable circumstances, releasing Soccer Development Group LLC. Boca Juniors Schools, as well as City of North Miami Beach and Club Atlético Boca Juniors, from any responsibility, including all trainers and authorities, and any other person or organization that might be involved.

SEVENTH.- The father/mother/tutor/guardian hereby authorizes Soccer Development Group, Boca Juniors Soccer Schools to call emergency services if the injury sustained is more serious than limited basic first aid can support.

Also may need to complete the FYSA medical release form and any tournament required release in order to participate.

EIGHTH.- The father/mother/tutor/guardian have read, acknowledge and respect the Boca Juniors Recreational Schools Code of Conduct, which is part of this contract.

NINTH.- The father/mother/tutor/guardian shall compensate the school for any damage the student causes to the facilities, team gear, uniforms, etc., within three days after being informed of said damages.



TENTH.- *Image rights.* I hereby acknowledge that Soccer Development Group LLC, Boca Juniors Academy at NMB, as well as any other official sponsor, may photograph or film an activity in order to promote, present, or develop for other commercial media related to the School and I hereby agree that they may photograph the child, record them on film, show them on live coverage or on any other media. I transfer irrevocably to Soccer Development Group LLC, Boca Juniors Soccer School and the official sponsors and subsidiaries the right, in perpetuity and all over the world, waiving the right to receive any compensation, to use said photographs, videos or film presentations, pictures, portraits and sound in all media, including but not limited to live television, new means of exhibition (mobile media and internet), television, catalogues, brochures, exhibits, and any other printed or written material, used to promote and advertise the School.

ELEVENTH.- *Risk liability.* I do hereby acknowledge that participating in the activities scheduled by the School presents inherent risks and the possibility of accidents occurring, resulting in, for example, severe injuries, including death, and the loss or damage of personal property. Having considered and acknowledged the nature, scope and dimension of the possible risks, I freely agree to take on those risks. I state under oath that the student is physically apt to play soccer, and I accept all risks of damages or injury.

TWELFTH.- *Release of liability.* I do hereby release Soccer Development Group LLC, Boca Juniors Academy and Club Atlético Boca Juniors and/or any and all of its sponsors and/or official providers, as well as its subsidiaries, directors, members, employees, representatives, insurers, and any other person involved with the School (hereinafter referred to as "Released parties") from any and all claims of loss, damages, injuries and death, from any inquiries, suits, expenditures (including legal fees), and from any other responsibility of any kind in relation to the student, myself, or any other person related, directly or indirectly, to the assistance of the student to the school.

THIRTEENTH.- *Insurance not included. Medical Expenses.* I acknowledge that Boca Juniors School shall not provide insurance coverage in case of accidents, sickness, death and/or civil liability, and they shall not be held responsible for any illness, accident, injury, loss or damage that may arise in relation to the participation of the student at the School. I have been informed and acknowledge that I should acquire insurance coverage to cover the student's presence during their stay at the School.

FOURTEENTH.- *First Aid.* I authorize Soccer Development Group LLC, Boca Juniors School, its representatives and staff to perform, if needed, first aid to the student, and call emergency services if the injury sustained is more serious than limited basic first aid can support..

FIFTEENTH.- *The player,* their parents, tutors and/or legal representatives under penalty of perjury hereby state that all information presented herein is true, and authorize Soccer Development Group LLC, Boca Juniors Official Soccer School to verify such information if they so desire.

SIXTEENTH.- Either party may terminate this agreement at any time with prior written notice. In the event the player request to leave the club prior to the conclusion of the agreement, all remaining unpaid fees become immediately due and the club may release the player, at its own discretion for a processing fee of \$350.

SEVENTEENTH: *Jurisdiction.* Any legal disputes stemming from the existence or contents of these presents shall be subject to the jurisdiction of State of Florida, US, establishing legal domiciles at the addresses stated herein.

- "The School" encourages the continuous improvement of the players. To learn through games, winning or losing, always having fun and enjoying team work and fair play.
- "The School" advocates Companionship, Compromise, Commitment, Mystique, Solidarity and Passion,
- "The School" aims to support students and provide them with physical and intellectual education.
- "The School" believes the physical and intellectual education of each student is critically important, as it understands both are essential for both present and future. Their wellbeing, health and integrity are core values for the School and Boca Juniors.
- "The School" expects responsibility from the students and understands that the way they present, dress and express themselves both while at School and outside, represent the School, the Club and its representatives.
- "The Student" understands this and agrees to maintain the respectable image and reputation, built through the years.

RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1°. The Student

"The Student" agrees to respect all rights and responsibilities set forth by "The School", in order to maintain the environment and atmosphere created. The Student's stay at the School will be subjected to their following of said rules and regulations

"Student" Responsibilities. "The Player" agrees:

- To train with the assigned group, at the scheduled time;
- To help maintain the facilities ;
- To Keep belongings in their designated place;



- iv. Not to steal or take items without asking first;
- v. To Repair or cover the costs of damage repair caused by the wrongful use of equipment, materials, uniforms, etc.
- vi. To treat everyone with respect and education, from employees to students, coaches, administrative staff, parents, etc.;
- vii. Not to Access restricted areas without express consent.
- viii. Not to bring alcoholic beverages, drugs of any kind, tobacco and/or guns to "School".
- ix. To accept all decisions taken by referees and coaches,
- x. To respect both the school and soccer rules,
- xi. To play for fun,
- xii. To play fair,
- xiii. To respect the opposite team,
- xiv. To join the team, and be a true player who gives their best every time
- xv. To wear the uniform at all School events.

Rights of "The Student". "The Student", as part of the School, has the right to receive education, safety and sports physical training, "The School" shall assign "The Student" a training Schedule. "The Student" shall follow the physical and sporting routine established by "The School", resting properly. "The Student" has the right to be treated with respect and education at all times by all "School" staff.

2°. Parents

Parents' obligations

Parents, adults, or any other person who wishes to stay with the Student during training sessions shall stay within the designated area at all times.

During matches and training sessions, we ask tutors, parents, etc:

- Not to shout in public, to your child, the coach, their teammates, members to the opposite team, parents, referees, etc
- Not to mistreat the referee,
- Not to belittle your child's teammates or members of the opposite team,
- To laugh and have fun watching your child play,
- Not to give lectures, that is the coach's job,
- To follow School rules and work with it
- To pay the monthly fee and enrollment fee on time.
- To participate in the parent-teachers conference.
- To respect your child's schedules

Those parents who fail to fulfill their obligations shall be suspended and will not be able to attend training sessions and/or matches. If there are repeated transgressions, the Student may be expelled from the School.



Parents' rights. Parents have the right to know and learn about the development programs implemented by the School for their child's training, as well as the child's evolution when it comes to soccer practice. They must register using Boca Juniors Schools software. Through it, they will be able to access all training programs, the objectives per age group and, mainly, their child's evolution, as presented by their coaches.

Don't forget that:

- It's just a game,
- Your child will always do their best,
- Your child will be happy with your support.

Rights and obligations of coaches, administrative staff and School staff

1. To respect both the school and soccer rules,
2. To be the first one to arrive and the last one to leave during training sessions and matches,
3. To value all students' efforts,
4. To always be up to date when it comes to their area of expertise,
5. To maintain clear communication channels
6. To be an example of good behavior and respect for their students
7. To be an example of cleanness and good hygiene

Discipline outside the field translates into results inside of it.

Suggestions and complaints:

Only the School coordinator (or whoever the school designates) shall be authorized to speak to parents, and they will be the only channel of communication. Coaches may not talk to parents.
